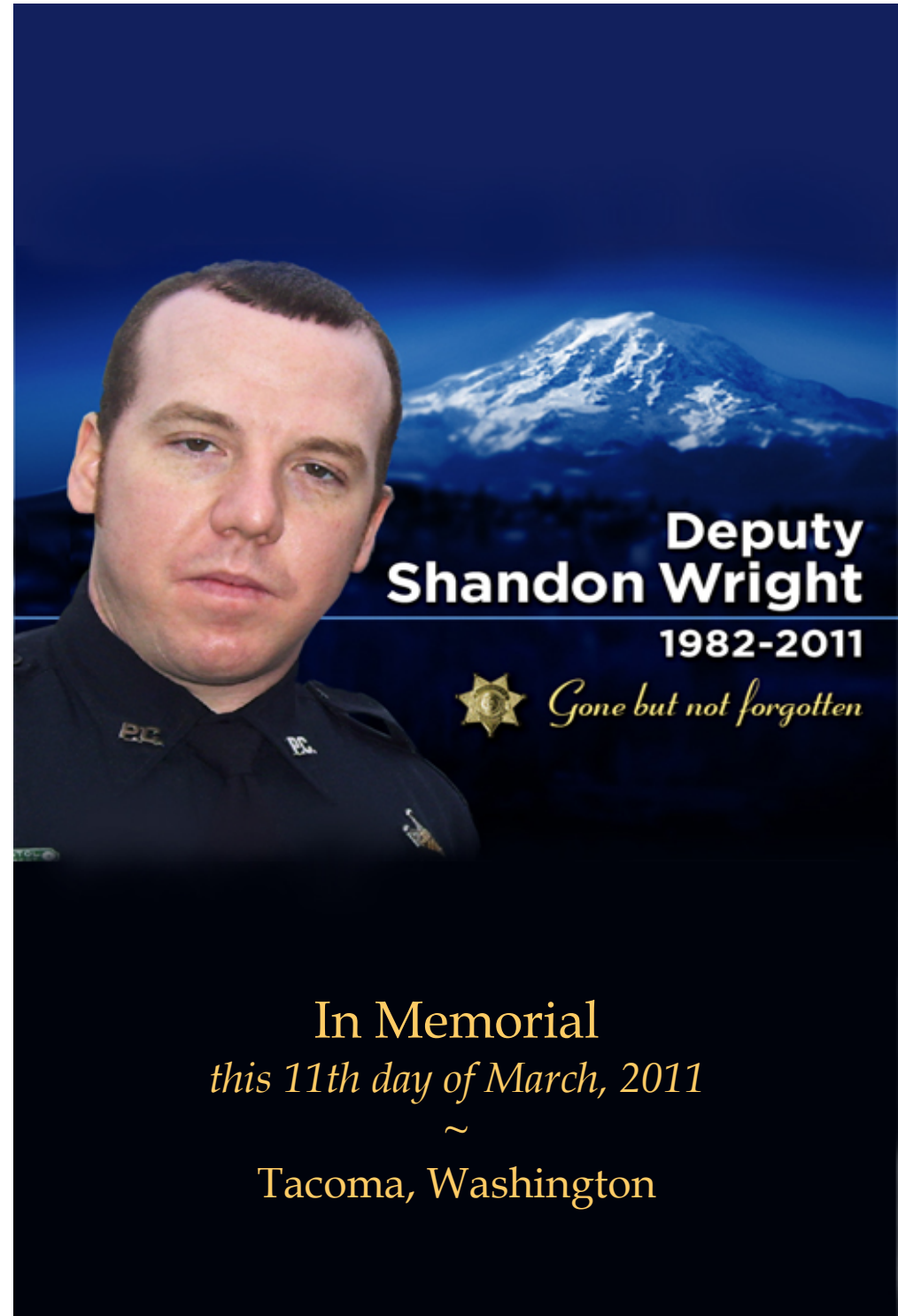

Champions Centre

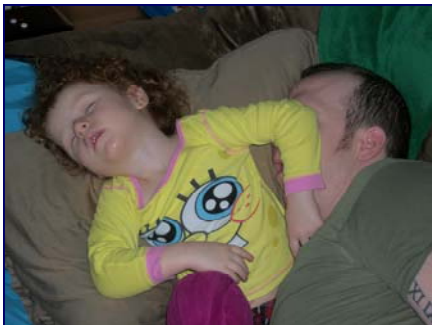


**S**handon Wright was born on January 8, 1982 in Redlands, California. He grew up in Apple Valley, California and graduated from Victorville High School in 2000. Shandon's father described him as a fun loving child, always happy and excited. He loved playing all sports, but baseball was his true passion. His father even thought he would play professional baseball because he was so passionate about the sport.



Shandon joined the United States Navy in 2001, and shortly after, became a United States Naval Master at Arms. While in the Navy, he met his best friend Scott Ostreicher, who was also a Master at Arms.

Although Shandon was passionate about a lot of things, he always wanted to be a police officer. Five years ago, Shandon was hired by the Pierce County Sheriff's Department and worked graveyard out of the Foothills Detachment and the South Hill Precinct. He was partnered with his good friend, Chris Olson. Combined, the two of them made numerous memorable arrests. For his efforts, Shandon received four Pierce County Sheriff's Department Patrol Impact Awards and in April, will be posthumously awarded a medal of merit.



Shandon is survived by his wife Janessa and daughter Madison. Shandon met his wife Janessa in 2003, and their marriage was described as love at first sight. Three years ago, Shandon and Janessa were blessed with the birth of their daughter, Madison. Janessa and Madison were Shandon's reason for being. As a graveyard deputy, it worked out perfectly that many of Madison's naps coincided
